
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


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SIGHT WORD GAMES:

- 1. <u>Concentration:</u> Choose 6-10 power words. Write each power word twice on index cards. Place the cards facing down. Take turns turning over the power words to find the match. Make sure to say the power word once you turn it over.
- 2. <u>Go Fish:</u> Write 5-7 power words on two sets of index cards. Shuffle the cards. Distribute the cards evenly to each player. Look to see if you have any matches. Then, take turns asking the other player if they have a word that you are holding in your hand. The player with the most cards at the end wins!
- Speed Game: Write 10 power words on an index card. Show the card one at a time to your child. Give your child 3-5 seconds to say the word. If you say the word before your child, you keep the card. If he or she says it first, hand the card to your child.

4. <u>Race Game:</u> Use the blank board game template to write the power words. Use a dice and game pieces of your choice to move across the board from start to end. <u>Option:</u> You can also write the words on index cards and board game on a table or floor. Be creative and have fun!

- Make inferences Students should be able to look for clues to understand more about the story or the characters.
 - **Example:** The little girl is wearing a sundress so it must be hot.

Suggested Activities

Log on to Bookshelf (arcbookshelf.com), choose a 1G text. Have your child read and retell the story. At the end of the story, ask your child questions about the story to check for comprehension.


Continued Suggested Activities:

Power Words Chart Paper: Cover paper with sight words repeated several times each. Give your child a different colored crayon and have them locate a word, read it to you, then they can circle it.



- Concentration: Make 2 cards for each word and lay all the words out facedown in a grid. Take turns turning over 2 cards. If the words match, and your child can read the word, they get the match.
- Kinesthetic Encoding: It's time to get active. Write the words on a large piece of paper, some poster board, an easel, or a blackboard. Ask your child to stand up and pretend to trace the letters in the air using his arm in big, sweeping motions as he slowly says the word (not the letters). Turn on some good tunes and have fun with the big motions.

 Race Game: Use the blank board game template to write the power words. Use a dice and game pieces of your choice to move across the board from start to end.
Option: You can also write the words on index cards and board game on a table or floor. Be creative and have fun!
